Interlinear Bible Search

INTERLINEAR may be defined as written or printed in different languages or texts in alternate lines. The Interlinear Bible Search enables you to research the subtle nuances and layers of meaning within the original biblical languages.

The basic purpose of the Interlinear Bible Search feature is to find the meaning of the original Hebrew, Aramaic, or Greek word. Sometimes many original language words have different and/or deeper meanings than the current understanding of the English word they are translated to.

To access the *Interlinear Bible Search* feature, select **BIBLE SEARCH** from the navigation bar located at the top of any page then select **INTERLINEAR BIBLE SEARCH** from the sub-navigation bar on the *Bible Search* page.

You may search for a keyword such as "love" or a Scripture reference such as "2 Thessalonians 2:3". Scripture references make up the most common search criteria.

The Greek Lexical Parser will list each word in the passage specified delineated by the Greek word. Selecting any **Strong's Number** will display the definition for that word. Selecting any **Greek Word** will display the **Greek Lemmatization** based on the Strong's Number. Greek Lemmatization displays the part of speech for the word as well as all the verses in the Bible using that form of the Greek word/Strong's Number.
