h) Rev. 12:11

l) 1 John 4:1-6

Question 1a (1)

Genesis 3:22-24

Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil; and now, lest he stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"-- ²³therefore the LORD God sent him out from the garden of Eden, to cultivate the ground from which he was taken. ²⁴So He drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden He stationed the cherubim, and the flaming sword which turned every direction, to guard the way to the tree of life.

Question 2

a) Rev 20:6, 14-15

⁶Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

¹⁴And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. ¹⁵And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Question 3a

1) Exodus 16:13-15

So it came about at evening that the quails came up and covered the camp, and in the morning there was a layer of dew around the camp. ¹⁴When the layer of dew evaporated, behold, on the surface of the wilderness there was a fine flake-like thing, fine as the frost on the ground. ¹⁵When the sons of Israel saw *it*, they said to one another, "What is it?" For they did not know what it was. And Moses said to them, "It is the bread which the LORD has given you to eat.

Exodus 16:26-35

"Six days you shall gather it, but on the seventh day, *the sabbath*, there will be none." ²⁷And it came about on the seventh day that some of the people went out to gather, but they found none. ²⁸Then the LORD said to Moses, "How long do you refuse to keep My commandments and My instructions? ²⁹"See, the LORD has given you the sabbath; therefore He gives you bread for two days on the sixth day. Remain every man in his place; let no man go out of his place on the seventh day." ³⁰So the people rested on the seventh day.

³¹And the house of Israel named it manna, and it was like coriander seed, white; and its taste was like wafers with honey. ³²Then Moses said, "This is what the LORD has commanded, 'Let an omerful of it be kept throughout your generations, that they may see the bread that I fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you out of the land of Egypt.' " ³³And Moses said to Aaron, "Take a jar and put an omerful of manna in it, and place it before the LORD, to be kept throughout your generations." ³⁴As the LORD

commanded Moses, so Aaron placed it before the Testimony, to be kept. ³⁵And the sons of Israel ate the manna forty years, until they came to an inhabited land; they ate the manna until they came to the border of the land of Canaan.

Hebrews 9:1-5

Now even the first *covenant* had regulations of divine worship and the earthly sanctuary. ²For there was a tabernacle prepared, the outer one, in which *were* the lampstand and the table and the sacred bread; this is called the holy place. ³And behind the second veil, there was a tabernacle which is called the Holy of Holies, ⁴having a golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which *was* a golden jar holding the manna, and Aaron's rod which budded, and the tables of the covenant. ⁵And above it *were* the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat; but of these things we cannot now speak in detail.

2) Deut. 8:3

"And He humbled you and let you be hungry, and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD.

3) John 6:31-40

"Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written, 'HE GAVE THEM BREAD OUT OF HEAVEN TO EAT.' " ³²Jesus therefore said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread out of heaven, but it is My Father who gives you the true bread out of heaven. ³³"For the bread of God is that which comes down out of heaven, and gives life to the world." ³⁴They said therefore to Him, "Lord, evermore give us this bread." ³⁵Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me shall not hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst. ³⁶"But I said to you, that you have seen Me, and yet do not believe. ³⁷"All that the Father gives Me shall come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out. ³⁸"For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. ³⁹"And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day. ⁴⁰"For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him, may have eternal life; and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."

John 6:48-51

"I am the bread of life. ⁴⁹"Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. ⁵⁰"This is the bread which comes down out of heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. ⁵¹"I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread also which I shall give for the life of the world is My flesh."

Question 4a

a) Psalm 2:1-12

Why are the nations in an uproar, And the peoples devising a vain thing? ²The kings of the earth take their stand, And the rulers take counsel together Against the LORD and against His Anointed: ³"Let us tear their fetters apart, And cast away their cords from us!" ⁴He who sits in the heavens laughs, The Lord scoffs at them. ⁵Then He will speak to them in His anger And terrify them in His fury: ⁶"But as for Me, I have

installed My King Upon Zion, My holy mountain." ⁷"I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'Thou art My Son, Today I have begotten Thee. ⁸'Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Thine inheritance, And the *very* ends of the earth as Thy possession. ⁹'Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron, Thou shalt shatter them like earthenware.' " ¹⁰Now therefore, O kings, show discernment; Take warning, O judges of the earth. ¹¹Worship the LORD with reverence, And rejoice with trembling. ¹²Do homage to the Son, lest He become angry, and you perish *in* the way, For His wrath may soon be kindled. How blessed are all who take refuge in Him!

2) Luke 19:11-19

And while they were listening to these things, He went on to tell a parable, because He was near Jerusalem, and they supposed that the kingdom of God was going to appear immediately. ¹²He said therefore, "A certain nobleman went to a distant country to receive a kingdom for himself, and *then* return. ¹³"And he called ten of his slaves, and gave them ten minas, and said to them, 'Do business *with this* until I come *back*.' ¹⁴"But his citizens hated him, and sent a delegation after him, saying, 'We do not want this man to reign over us.' ¹⁵"And it came about that when he returned, after receiving the kingdom, he ordered that these slaves, to whom he had given the money, be called to him in order that he might know what business they had done. ¹⁶"And the first appeared, saying, 'Master, your mina has made ten minas more.' ¹⁷"And he said to him, 'Well done, good slave, because you have been faithful in a very little thing, be in authority over ten cities.' ¹⁸"And the second came, saying, 'Your mina, master, has made five minas.' ¹⁹"And he said to him also, 'And you are to be over five cities.'

Question 4b

1) Daniel 12:1-4

Question 1a

1) Rev. 13:8

"A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE";

b) Rev 19:12
