### Lesson One

Days Three and Four

**Revelation** #602 – *apokaluosis*

Laying bare, uncovering, unveiling; disclosure of truth. To take off the cover. Used of events by which things or states or persons at one time were hidden from view are now made visible to all.

**Soon** #5034 – *tachos*

Quickness, speed, swiftness

**Communicated** #4591 – *semaino*

To give a sign, to indicate, to make known through signs.

**Blessed** #3107 *makarios*

Happy, fortunate; possessing the favor of God. The state of being marked by the fullness of God.

### Lesson Three

Day Three

**Remember** #3421 *mnemoneuo*

To call to remembrance; contemplate.

Present active imperative: Action accomplished by the subject of the verb; a command; continuous, repeated action.

**Have fallen** #1601 *ekpipto*

To drop away; to be off course; ineffective.

Perfect active indicative: Subject does the action; a stated fact; a process that took place in the past with results continuing to the present.

### Lesson Four

Days Two and Three

**First-born** #4416 - *prototokos*

First to bear or bring forth. Under the law the first born are peculiarly appropriated to God. A prominent position.

**First fruits** #536 - *aparche*

A beginning of sacrifice.

**Hades** #86 – *hades*

Region of departed spirits for the lost but included departed believers (Luke 16:23). It corresponds with Sheol of the Old Testament. It is not the grave or the pit; it is not the permanent region of the lost.

**Tribulation** #2347 - *thlipsis*

To break or crush; to squeeze or compress. Pressure of burden on the spirit due to circumstances.

**Poverty** #4432 – *ptocheia*

Beggary; indigence; to be poor without means.

Day Three

**Repent** #3340 – *metanoeo*

Regret accompanied by a true change of heart toward God.

Day Four

**Deeds** #2041 – *ergon*

To toil; effort; labor.

**Completed** #4137 – *pleroo*

To finish; accomplish; to fill up.

### Lesson Eight

Day One

**Philadelphia** #5359 – *philadelpheia*

From root word for brethren; fond of; fraternal affection.

**Holy** #40 – *hagios*

Sacred; pure; consecrated.

Day Four

**Testing** #3986 – *peirasmos*

To prove; experience; temptation; to be tried.

### Lesson Nine

Day Three

**Amen** #281 - *amen*

Trustworthy; surely; verily.

**Witness** #3144 – *martus*

A judicial witness; a record; a martyr.

**Beginning** #746 – *arche*

The first; to commence; the principle.

Day Four

**Wretched** #5005 – *talaiporos*

Enduring a trial; to be miserable. From root meaning to bear.

**Miserable** #1652 – *eleeinos*

To be pitied.

**Overcomes** #3528 – *nikao*

To conquer; to subdue; to prevail; get the victory.
